

**TRAFFIC REVIEW COMMITTEE MINUTES  
CITY OF FORT ATKINSON  
SEPTEMBER 8, 2016 - 2:00 p.m.**

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Selle at 2:00 p.m. in the Conference Room of the Police Department.

4.     Miscellaneous

a. Request for a four-way stop at the intersection of Talcott Avenue and Grove Street.

Selle reviewed a submission by resident Joseph Beavers requesting the Committee consider a four way stop at the intersection of Talcott Avenue and Grove Street. In the request from Mr. Beavers, he referenced an accident between a vehicle and a 13 year old child on a bicycle. No additional details of the accident were available, including the direction or speed of the vehicle or bicycle. No other accidents or requests for additional stop signs have been received. The Committee discussed monitoring the area and revisiting the request in December.

Selle made a motion to take no action at this time pending a traffic analysis of the intersection by the Police Department. Armstrong seconded the motion and carried. This item can be reviewed at the December meeting following traffic analysis.

b. Request for stop signs on South Fourth Street, west between South Main Street and Janesville Avenue.

Selle addressed a Traffic Review Request submitted by Emily Yavuzcetin in regard to South Main Street between the streets of South Main Street and Janesville Avenue. This section of

street runs east and west and does not currently have stop signs. The cross streets do have stop signs. The submission requests three stop signs. Bump confirmed the Police Department could monitor the area for speed and heavy traffic patterns.

Selle made a motion for the Police Department to observe traffic volumes from the Middle School and to monitor the street. Lescohier seconded the motion and carried. This item can be reviewed at the December meeting following traffic analysis.

The Committee discussed taking action upon the traffic concerns if they see a definite need for stop signs in the area of requests. Smith confirmed stop signs could be installed throughout the year pending weather.

Selle moved, seconded by Bump, to adjourn the Traffic Review Committee meeting at 2:35 p.m.
